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# EHR in a school setting

- ▶ **Medical professionals in a school setting are required to document the care they deliver as a component of professional practice**
  - ▶ School information systems (SIS) are not designed for medical documentation and reporting
  - ▶ EHRs Include nursing language and medical terminology
  - ▶ EHRs comply with standards of confidentiality, security, and privacy (HIPAA and FERPA)
- ▶ **Provides efficient data management processes**
  - ▶ Including enhanced analysis of student health data
- ▶ **Opportunities for interoperability with other systems**
- ▶ **Provide a legal document of care**

# Change Perception of What Nurses Do:

Today's school nurse is so much more than the stereotype of "ice, lice and band-aids."

School nurses serve as a **critical health hub** for students, ensuring that students are **ready for learning** by **managing complex, chronic conditions**; identifying and **addressing mental health issues**; **leveling the field** on health disparities and promoting healthy behaviors; enrolling children in health insurance and **connecting families to healthcare providers**; **handling medical emergencies**...and now, navigating through the COVID-19 pandemic by testing, **tracking and vaccinating** students and school personnel.

Types of No-Cost Services We Coordinate for Students

Doctor visits	Diabetes management
Asthma management	Special needs programs
Mental health services	Referrals to specialists
Cell phone access	Labs and x-rays
Unlimited transportation for doctor visits	Developmental delay evaluation and treatment
Surgeries (outpatient)	Prescriptions
Hearing aids	Home healthcare
Health condition diagnostic testing	Authorized therapies - physical, speech, occupational

# Benefits

Student Health Registration helps district create a more accurate representation of a student's health profile, directly from their families.

- Build a comprehensive student health information profile

- Parents can log in any time and update their child's health information— syncing any new student health updates into SchoolCare
- Paperless registration— aligns directly with your annual registration
- Parents fill out information, nurse is final approver of the info

# MCE and School Collaboration

- ▶ **Programming**
  - ▶ MHS Adopt A School
- ▶ **Access to Care**
  - ▶ School Based Health Clinic
  - ▶ School Based Telehealth Clinics



### School (ex. IPS)

- Access to care point for students via school nurse
- Visit information entered into EHR, including risk assessment for student

### SchoolCare

- Houses medical information for student
- Provides data and reporting for schools
- Provides data and reporting for consented Medicaid members to health plan

### MCE (ex. MHS)

- Receives reports for consenting members
- Triage members, placing into appropriate care coordination category and completes referral process

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# Care Coordination Opt-In

SchoolCare partners with local health plans to ensure SchoolCare is no cost for your district AND your under-resourced students receive access to no-cost health services.

Care Coordination is an opt-in program and we want to make sure that as many families as possible are getting access to this care!

There are different ways your district can collect opt-ins:

- SHR
- SIS registration
- Email campaign
- Parent App
- Share link in newsletters, on school webpage, social media, etc.

# Case Study



- ▶ MHS member noted on report to have uncontrolled asthma. Member had been unable to be reached previously by MHS Chronic Disease Health Coaches. Through the reporting, member is now enrolled with health coaching and asthma education.
- ▶ MHS member noted high risk of BH condition. Referral was made to MHS Behavioral Health Care Coordination. Care Coordinator will be able to assist member with finding a provider, medication management, and health information.
