What is 211?



Indiana 211 is a free service that connects Hoosiers with help and answers from thousands of health and human service agencies and resources right in their local communities - quickly, easily, and confidentially.

There are no eligibility requirements, income standards nor any other rules, anyone can call 2-1-1.



Indiana 211 Fast Facts

- Indiana 211 serves all residents in all 92 counties in Indiana
- There are over 6,500 agencies in the database with more than 20,000 services in the Indiana 211 database
- The database is maintained by full-time resource curators

Who should call 2-1-1?

- Any Hoosier looking for services can call Indiana 211 including:
 - Person who needs services
 - Medical Professional
 - Advocate
 - School Counselors, Social Workers
 - School Personnel
 - Neighbor, Friend
 - Family Member
- A caller does not need to be in crisis to call 2-1-1



Why should someone call 2-1-1?



- Indiana 211 can save an organization time by serving as a resource for staff.
- Someone has a need and not sure where to start call 2-1-1
- Callers are looking for help with something such as finding:
 - Food
 - Housing
 - **Utility assistance**
 - Clothing
 - **Education**
 - **Employment**
 - **Child Care**





What to Expect When Calling IN211

Indiana 211 Community Navigators



Community Navigators are connectors to community resources

 They ask a series of SDOH questions in an effort to understand where a person is at the time of the call.
 Sometime people call for one need, but in asking some additional questions, there may be other issues with which the community navigator can also offer resources.
 Often people do not know what to ask

IN211 SDoH Questions

FSA SOCIAL SERVICES

- 1. What is your current employment status?
- 2. What is your annual household income?
- 3. What is the highest level of education you have completed?
- 4. Do you currently smoke cigarettes?
- 5. Do you currently have health insurance?
- 6. What is your housing situation today?
- 7. Do you run out of food before you have money to buy more?
- 8. In the past 12 months has the electric, gas, oil or water company threatened to shut off services in your home?
- 9. Has a lack of transportation kept you from medical appointments, meetings, work or from getting things you need for daily living?
- 10. How often does anyone, including family, insult, talk down to you, or threaten you with harm?




- Anyone can search anytime by visiting IN211.org
 - Click on the Find Help at the top of the page which will then point to the on-line resource search




On-line Search IN211.org


 From this page you can start selecting the category for which resources are needed





Caller Demographics


